

Clinobehoite (Klinobehoite) - $\text{Be}(\text{OH})_2$

Hardness: 2–3. Cleavage: Perfect. Very likely to be toxic. Insoluble in water. Attacked by HCl or H_2SO_4 . May be sensitive to all acids to some extent. Attacked by alkalis.
