

## **Cornwallite - $\text{Cu}_5(\text{AsO}_4)_2(\text{OH})_4$**

Hardness = 4.5. Cleavage: Distinct/good. Attacked by acids.

Cornubite is a dimorph of cornwallite. These minerals are visually indistinguishable. Treat as cornwallite.
