

Darapskite - $\text{Na}_3(\text{SO}_4)(\text{NO}_3) \cdot \text{H}_2\text{O}$

Hardness: 2.5. Cleavage: Perfect. Readily soluble in water and dilute acids. Slightly soluble in acetone (crystals remain clear) and alcohol (probably ethanol; crystals become cloudy).
