

Hoelite - C₁₄H₈O₂

Hardness: No data. Cleavage: No data. AKA anthracene-9,10-dione or anthraquinone. Toxic by absorption. Possibly carcinogenic. Insoluble in water. Likely soluble to some extent in all organic solvents (acetone, alcohols).
