

Hohmannite - $\text{Fe}^{3+}_2(\text{SO}_4)_2\text{O}\cdot 8\text{H}_2\text{O}$

Hardness: 3. Cleavage: Perfect. Some sources indicate insoluble in cold water whereas Wight indicates sensitive to water. Rapidly soluble in dilute HCl. Unstable (dehydrates? hygroscopic?); store in sealed container.
