

Hydrocerussite - $\text{Pb}_3(\text{CO}_3)_2(\text{OH})_2$

Hardness: 3.5. Cleavage: Perfect. Insoluble in water. Easily soluble in acids including HNO_3 . Slightly soluble in aqueous CO_2 . Removed from galena with sulfamic acid, otherwise derusting with H_3PO_4 can deposit pyromorphite. Insoluble in ethanol.
