

Hydroglauoberite - $\text{Na}_{10}\text{Ca}_3(\text{SO}_4)_8 \cdot 6\text{H}_2\text{O}$

Hardness: No data. Cleavage: Distinct/good. Decomposes in water to form gypsum. Readily soluble in dilute acids.
