

Kainite - $\text{KMg}(\text{SO}_4)\text{Cl}\cdot 3\text{H}_2\text{O}$

Hardness: 2.5 - 3. Cleavage: Perfect. Readily soluble in water and acids. Insoluble in ethanol.

Hygroscopic; store in sealed container over desiccant.
