

Kaliborite (Paternoite) - $\text{KMg}_2\text{H}[\text{B}_6\text{O}_8(\text{OH})_5]_2(\text{H}_2\text{O})_4$

Hardness: 4 - 4.5. Cleavage: Perfect. Slightly soluble in water. Readily soluble in acids.
