

Medenbachite - $\text{Bi}_2\text{Fe}^{3+}\text{Cu}^{2+}(\text{AsO}_4)_2\text{O}(\text{OH})_3$

Hardness: 4.5. Cleavage: None observed. Attacked by HCl. May be sensitive to NH_3 or dithionite.
