

Monohydrocalite - $\text{CaCO}_3 \cdot \text{H}_2\text{O}$

Hardness: 2–3. Cleavage: Perfect. Very likely attacked by all acids to some extent. Dehydrates; store in sealed container. Otherwise treat as calcite.
