Hardness: Variable; soft. Cleavage: Variable. A term used for minerals having a compact, fibrous or felt-like morphology (asbestiform), commonly <u>actinolite</u> (byssolite), <u>chrysotile</u>, <u>palygorskite</u>, <u>saponite</u>, <u>serpiolite</u> and <u>tremolite</u>. Soft; easily damaged.
