

Mrázekite - $\text{Bi}_2\text{Cu}_3(\text{PO}_4)_2\text{O}_2(\text{OH})_2 \cdot \text{H}_2\text{O}$

Hardness: 2–3. Cleavage: Distinct/good. Very sensitive to HCl. Attacked by H_2SO_4 or oxalic acid.
May be sensitive to all acids to some extent, as well as NH_3 or dithionite.
