

Polyhalite - $\text{K}_2\text{Ca}_2\text{Mg}(\text{SO}_4)_4 \cdot 2\text{H}_2\text{O}$

Hardness: 2.5 - 3.5. Cleavage: Perfect. Attacked by water, faster when warm. Soluble in dilute acids.
