## Pyrope - Mg<sub>3</sub>Al<sub>2</sub>(SiO<sub>4</sub>)<sub>3</sub>

Hardness: 7 - 7.5. Cleavage: None observed. Excellent chemical resistance. Often zoned growth with other garnet species, mostly almandine.

Varieties/related species (treat same as pyrope): Almandine (see separate listing), rhodolite
