

Sideronatrite - $\text{Na}_2\text{Fe}(\text{SO}_4)_2(\text{OH}) \cdot 3\text{H}_2\text{O}$

Hardness: 1.5 - 2. Cleavage: Perfect. Water sensitive but insoluble in cold water. Readily attacked by acids.

Varieties/related species (treat same as sideronatrite): Metasideronatrite.
