

Symphesite - $\text{Fe}^{2+}_3(\text{AsO}_4)_2 \cdot 8\text{H}_2\text{O}$

Hardness: 2.5. Cleavage: Perfect. Soluble in acids.

See also köttigite-parasympesite, with which this species may be associated and/or intergrown.
