

Uranospinite - $\text{Ca}(\text{UO}_2)_2(\text{AsO}_4)_2 \cdot 10\text{H}_2\text{O}$

Hardness: 2 - 3. Cleavage: Perfect. Radioactive. Micaceous; fragile. Attacked by acids. May dehydrate; store in sealed container.
