## Variscite - AlPO<sub>4</sub>·2H<sub>2</sub>O

Hardness: 3.5 - 4.5. Cleavage: Distinct/good. Rohner indicates sensitivity to moisture but this is questionable. Tolerates distilled water. Slowly attacked by HCl and other acids. Avoid strong detergents. NH<sub>3</sub>, NaOH and other alkalis.

Varieties/related species (treat same as variscite): Metavariscite.
